2026 Summer Camp Rates:

2025-26 Club Membership (**\$25.00**) is required to enroll in summer camp program.

REGULAR CAMP DAY: 8:00 AM -4:00 PM

- Weekly Camp Rate = \$300.00 (5 days)
- Week 1 = \$120.00(2 days)
- Week 2 = \$240.00 (4 days)
- Weeks 3,5,7,9 Rate = \$330.00 (includes cost of fieldtrip)

OPTIONAL EXTENDED DAY: 4:00 PM - 5:30 PM

- Additional \$50.00 per week (5 day weeks)
- Additional \$40.00 per week (4 day weeks)
- Additional \$20.00 per week (2 day weeks)

Non-Refundable deposit of \$75.00 per session is required to register. Full Tuition is due on June 1st for June/July weeks, and July 1st for August weeks.

Policies and Safety Information 1

REGISTRATION

Please visit www.watertownbgc.org/summer or scan QR code to register online. Alternatively, please download, complete, and submit the registration forms in full from our website along with payment to Watertown Boys & Girls Club as directed below.



****IMPORTANT:** Immunization Records and a completed Camp Form from your child's physician are required per MA Department of Public Health regulations. These **MUST** be submitted at the time of registration.**

To register, a **NON-REFUNDABLE** deposit of \$75.00 for each session is required. **Balance must be paid by June 1 for June & July sessions, and July 1 for August Sessions. Failure to pay balance by due date could result in forfeiture of your child's spot.**

Any cancellation made less than one week in advance will result in forfeiting the entire week's fee. Any behavioral problems or violation of Club or camp rules will result in camper being suspended from the summer program with **NO REFUND** in camp fees. All campers must be a registered member of Watertown Boys & Girls Club. The \$25.00 membership fee is non-refundable.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **ONLINE:** Make payment with a Credit Card* via online registration (Preferred).
*Credit card fees apply.
- **IN PERSON:** Drop completed registration forms and payment with Cash, Check (made payable to "Watertown Boys & Girls Club")
- **MAIL:** Mail completed registration forms and payment by check to our address listed below.

Payment can be made in full at the time of registration. Otherwise, a \$75.00 non-refundable deposit per camper per week is required at the time of registration to hold your spot. Payment of the remaining balance for each week of camp must be made in full as follows:

Weeks 1 - 6: Payment in full by June 1, 2026, **Weeks 7 -11:** Payment in full by July 1, 2026.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO PARENT GUARDIAN

Child must be a registered camper of Watertown Boys & Girls Club, Club Adventure Camp, and a summer member of WBGC. The membership must be valid through August 30, 2025. The child may participate in the activities offered at the Club. The membership fees are non-refundable.

Campers may be used in photos, videos, literature and news releases when taking part in Club events and at the Summer Program.

Campers may be transported in the Club's vans or associated vehicles to and from the Summer Program activities and related events. Parent will assume full responsibility for any accidents incurred, hereby releasing Watertown Boys & Girls Club, it's staff and it's directors of all liabilities.

Campers may be provided with sunscreen if they run out of their personal sunscreen or if they forgot/ did not arrive with sunscreen. Please check with staff for the sunscreen products currently in use at the Club.

CAMPER SUPERVISION

Please note that WBGC is unable to provide 1-to-1 care/supervision during our Club Adventure Summer Camp program. If your child has specialized care or supervisory requirements, please contact us to discuss prior to enrolling in the program.

CAMPER PICK-UP POLICY

Campers registered for the regular camp day must be picked up no later than 4:00 PM. Campers enrolled in extended day must be picked up no later than 5:30 PM. Campers must be signed out each day by an adult listed on their authorized pick-up list and prepared to show identification each day. A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged for late pick up. Continual late pickup may result in a child's suspension or removal from the program.



This camp must comply with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and be licensed by the Local Board of Health.

Club Rules and Member Expectations

FIELD TRIPS

CLUB RULES

- All members are expected to respect Club staff, other Club members and all Club property at all times.
- Use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited. Anyone caught breaking this rule will be suspended indefinitely and his/her parents will be notified.
- Foul or abusive language is prohibited.
- Fighting, play fighting, punching, shoving, wrestling, snowball fights, etc., are prohibited.
- Food and drink are permitted in the Gamesroom ONLY! Please recycle in the bins provided and throw away all trash. No food is permitted in the gym. Only clear liquids are permitted in the gym (i.e. water)
- Members are reminded not to bring valuables into the Club, as the Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- The Front Desk Staff is not permitted to hold valuables for any member behind the Front Desk.
- Club phones are for business use. Members may only use the phone in the case of an emergency.
- If a member is having a problem with another Club member, it should be reported to a staff member immediately.
- If a member is hurt or not feeling well, they need to report this to a staff member immediately.
- Proper swimming attire is required for the pool. Swimmers that wish to use goggles must bring their own.
- Members should wear appropriate clothing at all times. This includes clothing that is in good taste, non-revealing and without negative or foul wording in the design.
- Any damage to Club property will result in suspension from the Club, as well as restitution for all damages.

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Watertown Boys & Girls Club Behavior Management Policy

BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT POLICY:

Behavioral Issues will be handled as follows:

Inappropriate Behavior: Staff will reinforce that the behavior and its consequences are in the member's control. An immediate consequence will be given for inappropriate behavior. The Club maintains that repeated warnings do little to change behavior.

Minor Incidents: include but are not limited to: pushing and shoving, not listening, misbehaving, name calling, throwing things, and swearing. Staff members may draw from a range of behavior modification methods to establish what will work for the individual child. Examples include time outs, restrictions from activities or program areas, writing apology letters, practicing alternative behaviors.

Major Incidents: include but are not limited to: fighting or attempting to injure, bullying, stealing, running away from the group, disrespect toward the Club staff or equipment, and/or throwing objects at staff or members. Major incidents are immediately referred to the Club's Leadership Staff and consequences may include extended restrictions from activities or program areas, suspension or expulsion. Parents will be contacted.

No child will be subjected to corporal punishment, including spanking, cruel or severe punishment, humiliation or verbal abuse. No child will be denied food or shelter as a form of punishment. No child will be punished for soiling, wetting or not using the toilet.
